

Call for papers:

Coexisting in/as diversified societies. Roma communities in a globalised world.

Time: **22-24 May, 2017**

Place: **Södertörn University, Stockholm, Sweden**

The conference is a continuation to the *SWEDISH NATIONAL BANK PROGRAMMES 2018: Kick-Off Workshop for Research Funding in Romani Studies* organised at the University of Helsinki on 27-28 February, 2017. The papers of this conference will form the basis of the project proposal for Riksbanken Programmes funding. The papers will also be published in an edited volume by the end of 2017.

The submitted paper abstracts should address the question of coexistence and globalisation from a multidisciplinary perspective, using the plurality approach to Roma groups and showing intra-group diversification. Country-specific case studies related to one or more of the project's subthemes and connecting to the umbrella topic are strongly encouraged. The subthemes are 1) Roma inequalities and emancipation, 2) Coexistence with non-Roma society and interaction with the global society, and 3) Aspects of Ethnic Identity within Roma Youth (16-25 years).

Researchers must send a one-page abstract of their presentation on the theme proposed above to daria.pritup@helsinki.fi. The deadline for abstracts is **15 April, 2017**. Accepted participants will be notified by **22 April, 2017**. Submitting the abstract is a prerequisite to participation. The travel and accommodation expenses of approved participants will be covered by NAIRS.
