## Connecting to Södertörn University's Wi-Fi networks

Södertörn University has two networks you can connect to: Eduroam and SH Guest. You should primarily choose Eduroam, because SH Guest is mainly for temporary visitors. To log in, use your username (which ends with suni.se) and the password you created for your SH-Account.

### EDUROAM

You can connect to Eduroam by choosing Eduroam from the available networks on your computer or phone. Enter your SH-Account details when prompted, i.e. username@sun.se and the password you have chosen.

Some settings may need to be made, especially on Android phones. They can vary, but basically look like this:

## Forget network

If you have changed your password for your SH-Account, you need to do a “forget this network”. Do this by right-clicking on Eduroam. Or go to Settings – Networks – Eduroam – click on the network and then “Forget”.

Once you have done this, you will be asked to re-enter your account details next time you connect to Eduroam. Then you just enter your new password.

### Forget network - MAC

Choose the Apple menu  > System settings and click on Network.

Select Wi-Fi in the list to the left.

Click on Advanced.

Click on Create.

### Forget network - iPads, iPhones

1. Go to settings > Wi-Fi.
2. Click on  beside the Wi-Fi network you want the device to forget.

Click Forget this network and then click on Forget to confirm this.

### If you have a Mac computer that already has/has a suni account via another education provider

When someone has been connected to Eduroam via a Mac at another education provider, other settings are saved as a “profile” that stays even though you forget the network. You need to remove this profile and add a new password to access Eduroam via Södertörn University.

You need to enter your computer’s network settings, as follows:

In OS X 10.8 or higher, remove the profile via System Preferences. You will need administrator rights on the computer.

1. Select System Preferences from the Apple menu.
2. Select Profiles.
3. All the saved profiles will load.
4. Click on Eduroam wireless network to select it. Then click on the minus sign at the bottom to remove it.

Close open windows on the computer. You can now connect to and select the network again to connect to Eduroam.
