Some information about what you need to do before you start studying:

1. SH-Account

After the final admission decision, you will receive an e-mail from Södertörn University telling you how to create your SH-Account. When you have an SH-Account, you can log in to Student-Ladok and register for your course/programme via the internet.

2. Registration and roll-call

To study at Södertörn University you must register on the course/programme you have been admitted to. There may also be an obligatory roll-call. Information about roll-call/registration for your course/programme will have been sent to you in a letter or e-mail.

3. SH-Card

After registration, you can collect your SH-Card at the reception. (Week 36 and 37 you collect it at level 6 instead – follow the signs!) Remember to take valid ID with you!

Study Information Desks

The university has three study information desks, which are responsible for practical administration:

- A** **ME 455 – The School of Culture and Education (IKL), Teacher Education and Police Education**
Subjects: Aesthetics, Art History, Comparative Literature, English, Education, Gender Studies, Media and Communication Studies, Philosophy, Rhetoric, Studies in Practical Knowledge, Swedish; Teacher Education and Police Education
- B** **ME 5 – The School of Natural Sciences, Technology and Environmental Studies (NMT) and the School of History and Contemporary Studies (HHS)**
NMT subjects: Biology, Development Studies, Environmental Science, Geography, International Health, Meal Sciences, Media Technology and Tourism Studies
IHS subjects: Archaeology, Archive Studies, Ethnology, History, History of Ideas and Study of Religions
- C** **ME 5 – The School of Social Sciences (ISV)**
Subjects: Business Studies, International Relations, Journalism, Economics, Public Law, Psychology, Social Work, Sociology and Political Science.
